Compliance Status

This website is Partially Compliant with Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.2 at the Single A (A) and Double A (AA) levels due to the non-conformities listed below.

Test results

The compliance audit carried out by Barclays accessibility team identified that 55% of the functional conformance criteria are supported.

Non-accessible content

The following content is not fully accessible due to the following reasons.

We are aware of the following accessibility issues in limited locations on our website:

Text Alternatives

- 1.1.1 Non-text Content: a few images are missing or have inaccurate alternative text which may make it more difficult for people with visual impairments using assistive technology to navigate the content.

Adaptable

- 1.3.1 Info and relationships: the code on pages does not accurately convey the content structure which will make it difficult for screen reader and assistive technology users to understand the content.

Distinguishable

- 1.4.3 Contrast (Minimum): in some instances, there is not enough contrast between text and background which could make it difficult for people with low vision or who have difficulties distinguishing colours.
- 1.4.4 Resize text: some content is cropped or overlapping when the site is zoomed in which may make it more difficult for people with low vision or who need larger text.
- 1.4.5 Images of text: some images contain text which is present in text content which may make it more difficult for people with visual impairments or cognitive disabilities to access.

- 1.4.10 Reflow: not all content can be viewed or accessed when zoomed to 400% without requiring two-dimensional scrolling which may make it more difficult for people with low vision or who need larger text.
- 1.4.13 Content on Hover or Focus: content in header menu which appears on mouse hover cannot be dismissed using the keyboard which can impact people with low vision, motor difficulties or cognitive disabilities.

Keyboard Accessible

- 2.1.1 Keyboard: navigation menus and many interactive elements are not accessible via keyboard which will make it difficult for keyboard navigation users to navigate the site, including individuals with motor difficulties or those that rely on assistive technology.

Navigable

- 2.4.1 Bypass Blocks: there is no mechanism to skip repeated content which will make it more difficult for individuals with motor difficulties or those that rely on assistive technology.
- 2.4.3 Focus Order: in some instances, keyboard focus is not logical which will make it more difficult for keyboard only users.
- 2.4.4 Link Purpose (In Context): in some instances, link labels do not clearly explain what each link does which may confuse users.
- 2.4.7 Focus visible: the site does not have a visible indicator for elements that have keyboard focus making it more difficult to operate the controls for those who rely on keyboard operation or have cognitive disabilities.

Input Assistance

- 3.3.2 Labels or Instructions: some form elements do not provide persistent labels or instructions which may make it more difficult for those who rely assistive technology or have cognitive disabilities.

Compatible

4.1.2 Name, Role, Value: some interactive controls lack correct programmatic roles, states or names so will not be correctly communicated to assistive technology which can confuse assistive technology users.

Office File Formats

PDFs files available through the website do not meet accessibility requirements and are non-conformant.

Exemptions for disproportionate burden

Where possible we aim to make all content accessible. However, some content is exempt from the legal obligations to be made accessible. This includes older files and views, live or archived content and third-party content that is not funded or developed by the Barclays and is not under its control.
